### Simple search

This field allows you to enter keywords to search throughout the entire database.

Multiple keywords separated by spaces indicate an AND connection between the keywords (e.g. Hadrian Tivoli). Place a minus sign in front of the keyword for a AND NOT combination (e.g. Athen -Akropolis).

In order to search for complete phrases, place these in quotation marks (e.g. "Gott aus dem Meer").

Die Ostfront wurde dadurch betont, daß die Ringhalle hier 2 Joche und an den übrigen Seiten 1 Joch tief ist. Vor die Cella wurde eine 4 x 2-säulige Vorhalle gelegt. Es fehlt das Horizontalgeison des Giebels. Der Tempel wurde aus lokalem Muschelkalkstein errichtet, allerdings wurde die Triglyphen und die ionischen Profile aus Sandstein gefertigt. Die Bauteile waren stuckiert und bemalt. Gebäudetyp speziell: dorischer Peripteros
